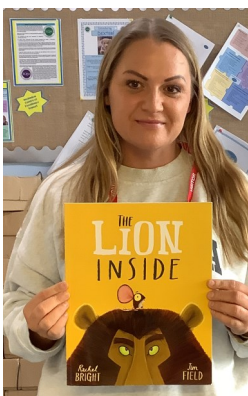

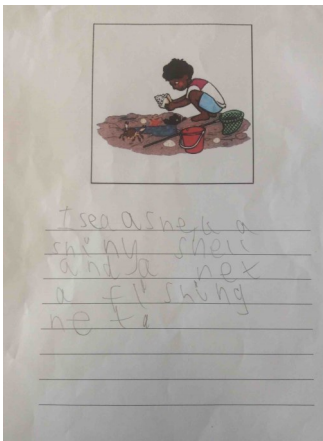

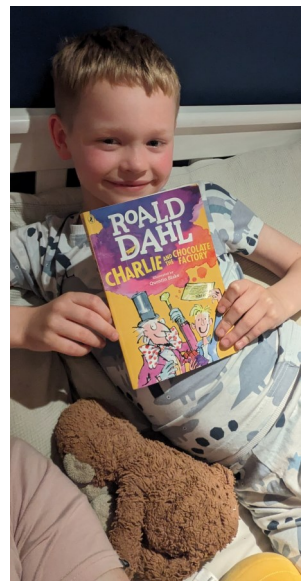

I am a powerful tiger

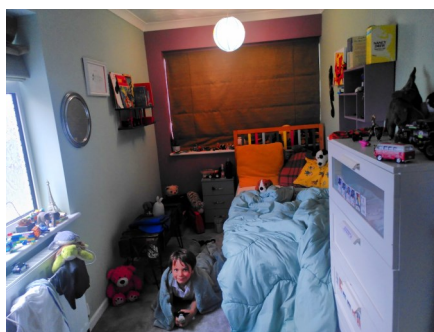
I have so many powerful clouds.

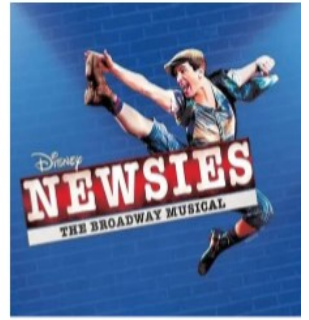
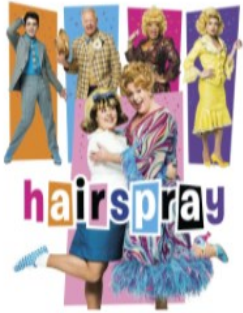
