Why do you love me so much?



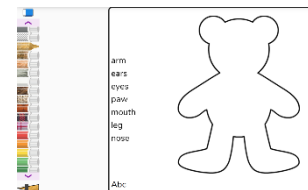
Expressive Arts and Design
