Next week we will be learning about Owls. We will be visited by some Owls on Wednesday.



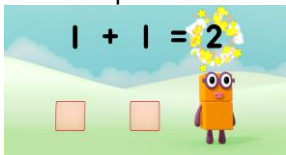
Expressive Arts and Design

Literacy
